Now that you have a foster dog in your care, please be aware of the following -

Your foster dog is on our website and up for adoption - Adoptions can happen at any time. If you have anyone (including yourself) interested in adopting your dog please contact us ASAP by EMAIL ONLY at info@cortezrescue.org. All adoptions are on a first come basis.

Please give your foster dog time to bond with you before taking them out in public – Some dogs can be very shy and scare easily which could make them a "flight risk." Nobody wants to lose a foster dog so please be aware at all times of how they are acting/reacting to situations.

If you are fostering a puppy under 6 months – We strongly suggest you DO NOT take them to public areas such as beaches and restaurants where "local dogs" hang out. Most "local dogs" are not vaccinated and could easily spread disease to your young foster pup.

When you walk or take your foster dog with you – Always, Always, Always have your pup on a leash. Also make sure to put on their "Adopt Me" bandana so that people are aware that your well-behaved foster is looking for their furever home.

Your foster dog may need veterinarian visits while in your care – Cortez Rescue will notify you when your foster dog is due for a vet visit. Please let us know if you will need assistance in getting your pup to the vet clinic and we will arrange transportation.

When your foster dog leaves your care – Please make sure to gather all supplies such as crates, beds, bowls, toys, bandanas, leashes, etc... Getting everything returned to us helps keep our expenses down and that money can be used to help other dogs in need.

WE NEED YOUR FEEDBACK! You are the key to getting your foster dog adopted - It is very important that you update us on how your pup is doing as they adjust in your home. Skills, behaviors, sensitivities, etc... You will be receiving a follow-up email - please reply to it with updates so that we can add it to their online profile for potential adopters and to make the best home match decisions.
